Medina County is accepting applications for the following position:

JOB TITLE: ANIMAL CONTROL

REQUIREMENTS:

Captures and removes stray, uncontrolled or abused animals from undesirable conditions using a variety of hand tools.
Impounds animals, contacts known owners, arranges for adoption of unclaimed animals and provides care to animals while in custody.
Euthanizing animals that are severely injured, terminally ill, or unadoptable, following established legal and humane procedures.
Maintains shelter, animal control vehicles, pens and enclosures.
Examines animal licenses and inspects establishments housing animals for compliance with appropriate laws.
Examines animals for injuries and malnutrition and arranges for any necessary medical treatment.
Issues warnings and citations related to animal-related offenses. Contacts police to report violations and requests arrests, if needed.
Prepares paperwork for prosecutions related to animal mistreatment and provides evidence in court.
Educates the public about animal welfare and animal control laws and regulations.
Performs other duties, special projects and tasks as assigned.
