All of the addresses in Medina County are based on the location of the driveway to the property or front door (point of entry for emergency services). If the customer has a driveway in place, the Medina County 9-1-1 Addressing Coordinator will go to the property and take a physical GPS reading from the driveway, then the coordinates will be taken to the Medina County 9-1-1 office to be converted into an address. From that point, all parties involved will be notified of the address.

If the customer does not have a driveway in place, someone will need to go to the property and mark where the driveway or structure will be located in the future. They may use stakes, spray paint, flags, etc. to clearly mark where the driveway will be located. The Medina County 9-1-1 Addressing Coordinator must be notified when and how the driveway is marked before she will go out in the field to get the GPS reading.

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The Addressing Coordinator typically goes out in the field for addressing on Fridays. So long as the driveway is in place/has been marked, the address request will be added to the weekly route. Depending on the amount of addresses to be done on that day, the customer will be contacted by the Addressing Coordinator that Friday afternoon or the following Monday morning, via telephone, email, etc. If needed, an Address Verification letter can be provided.
